State versus Bablu Yadav

Sh. Snehpal Singh, Advocate filed power of attorney on behalf of the accused. Taken on record.

Main file bearing CIS No.SC-30-2025, pending in this Court has been put up and perused. Heard on the bail application under section 483 BNSS filed by Bablu Yadav(applicant/accused) for grant of regular bail in FIR No.79 dated 06.09.2024, U/ss 103(1), 66 BNS, P.S. Malaud, Ludhiana. FIR was lodged on 06.09.2024 on the statement of Gulraj Singh(here-in-after referred to as complainant) to the effect that he is a Painter. He used to reside alongwith his wife/victim and three children. In his village, Bablu Yadav son of Girja Yadav had been living in the house of Jasvir Singh resident of Siaar for about 30-32 years, whom the above Jasvir Singh had thrown out of his house about 3-4 months ago. A few days ago, his wife/victim told him that Bablu Yadav had been un-necessarily harassing her while passing by from many days and complainant had forbidden Bablu Yadav(applicant/accused) from doing so many times, but he did not desist. On that day, at about 07:15 PM, his wife/victim had gone to someone's house in Lodhi Patti for some work after telling him. But, she did not return home until around 08:30 PM. So, he went for her search. When he reached near the government milk diary, near the Lodhi Patti turn, near hospital, Bablu Yadav(applicant/accused) came from the un-inhabited place on the left side

hurriedly. On Seeing him, he got suspicious and called him by name, but he ran towards Siaar village. At that moment, he called Pargat Singh son of Balbir Singh of their village and told him the whole story. They went to the uninhabited place on the left side and saw that on the right side, near heap of Achaar, a body of a woman was lying in a half-naked condition. When he went closer and looked, it was the body of his wife/victim. He and Sarpanch went near the body and saw that there were injury marks on the left side of her face and blood was oozing and her throat also seemed to have been strangled with a chunni and blood was also flowing from her private parts, so they called Jasvir Singh son of Gurmail Singh and his brother Jagjit Singh son of Hari Singh, resident of Siaar and in the meantime, Pargat Singh informed the police and police came at the spot and saw the body of his wife. Videography and photography of the spot was got done. The complainant further stated that he was sure that his wife was murdered by Bablu Yadav. The reason for committing the crime was that his wife had told him about his wrongdoings many days ago. On the basis of said statement, the present FIR was registered. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that the complainant i.e. husband of the victim when appeared in the Court as Pw-1 has turned hostile. Pargat Singh, Pw-2 has also not supported the case of the prosecution. In this case, substantial number of witnesses are yet to be examined. Culpability would be decided thereafter. The bail application is pre-mature. As such, the same stands dismissed. Papers be tagged with the main file.
