This is an application under Section 482 BNSS seeking anticipatory bail being moved on behalf of applicant/accused Akash.

1. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that the applicant/accused is innocent and he is not concerned with the pistol found at the spot; in fact, it is an admitted case of the Prosecution that the pistol was not recovered from or at the instance of the applicant/accused; further, it is also not in dispute that the applicant/accused has not used the weapon in question and rather, he was not even involved in the scuffle and has been falsely implicated in the present case.

2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has further submitted that the only offence alleged against the applicant/accused is under Section 25 of the Arms Act and has contended that the case of the applicant/accused squarely falls within the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar* and *Satender Kumar Antil v. CBI*, wherein it has been emphasized that arrest and detention should not be resorted to mechanically in cases punishable with imprisonment up to seven years and that liberty of an accused ought to be protected. However, the applicant/accused is ready to join the investigation of the present case and is also ready to co-operate in the same and it is prayed that interim protection be

granted to the applicant/accused.

3. IO has stated that the applicant/accused may be directed to join the investigation of the present case.

4. Submissions heard. Record perused.

5. The applicant/accused Akash is directed to join the investigation of the present case, as and when directed by the IO. No coercive action be taken against the applicant/accused subject to his joining the investigation as and when called upon by the IO, till the next date of hearing.

6. Put up for filing of further status report on **03.07.2026**.

7. Copy of this order be given dasti to the parties and to the IO.
