Present:- Sh. Kumar Shivam, Advocate for petitioner.
Sh.Mohd. Rafi, Advocate for Insurance Company.
Respondent no. 1 & 2 in person.
Ld. Counsel for petitioner has filed fresh memo of parties.

At this stage, an application made on behalf of petitioner for direction to Medical Superintendent for issuance of disability certificate.

Ld. Counsel for petitioner has submitted that there is a probability that the petitioner has suffered permanent disability due to the accident.

Heard. Application perused. Allowed.

In view of the above, M.S., GTB Hospital is requested to constitute a medical board for evaluation of nature and extent of disability of the petitioner namely **Master Sameer** and submit report in this court on or before next date of hearing. Separate order in specified format (Form J) be sent to the M.S., GTB Hospital to do the needful in time bound manner. The petitioner is directed to approach MS of the hospital within 10 days for assessment. Copy of this order be sent to M.S., GTB Hospital for compliance alongwith the disability certificate, the assessment sheet be also enclosed and M.S., GTB Hospital is requested to incorporate in the disability certificate as to what all activities the petitioner / injured will not be able to carry out due to the disability. Copy of this order be given to petitioner free of cost.

On examination of the parties, it has transpired that at the time of accident, offending vehicle was into the possession of driver Pradeep, however, perusal of record shows that driver Pradeep has not been made party in the instant matter.

In view of the submissions, IO of this case be called for clarification on the NDOH.

In the meanwhile, respondents are directed to file their WS/reply within 30 days with advance copy of the same to the petitioner.
