ORDER:

1. This order shall dispose of an application moved on behalf of the aforesaid applicants/accused seeking bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in the above mentioned FIR.

2. It is submitted by the applicants/accused that the applicants/accused are innocent and have committed no offence. All the allegations levelled in the FIR are false and frivolous and they have been misunderstandingly named by the complainant. The applicants/accused are ready and willing to join the investigation and they also undertake to abide

by all the terms and conditions as imposed by the Court, if they are granted bail.

3. Notice of this application was given to the State. Record from the concerned Police Station was summoned. ASI-Sukhwinder Singh No.28 has produced the record.

4. I have heard the arguments and have gone through the record.

5. The present FIR has been got registered on the statement of Parshotam Lal, complainant. Earlier, the FIR was registered for one of the offences under Section 308 IPC, but now that has been converted into 307 IPC. As per the allegations in the FIR, applicant/accused-Sawan Sahota caused head injury with iron road and applicant/accused-Gagan @ Gaggi Gandhi caused injuries with base-bat on the person of Rohit son of the complainant. The applicants/accused have been specifically named in the FIR and specific injuries have been attributed to them. Thus, the allegations against the applicants/accused are serious in nature. The custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused is required. The weapons, allegedly used in the commission of crime, are also required to be recovered to complete the investigation. Thus, I do not find any ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the applicants/accused. Accordingly, the application in hand stands dismissed. Police record be returned and file of this Court be consigned to the Record Room.
