Bail application put up before me being Duty Magistrate.

Police record received and perused. Arguments on bail application, heard.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has argued that applicant-accused is innocent person and falsely implicated in this case. The applicant was unaware of this fact and as such did not appear before the court and was accordingly declared as Proclaimed Offender and accordingly present FIR was registered against the applicant/accused under Section 174-A of IPC. Accused/applicant has not committed any offence as he was not aware of the pendency of any FIR against him. The presentation of challan and trial will take long time. Therefore no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused-applicant. *He further argued that no such application has been decided or pending in any competent Court of India.*

On the other hand, Ld. APP for the state submitted that offence is serious, so application may kindly be dismissed.

Considered. The accused is in custody since his arrest. The presentation of challan and its trial will take long time and no useful purpose will be served to keep the accused behind the bars. Keeping in view the custody of the applicant/accused and above said circumstances,

the bail application is allowed. Applicant/accused Akshay Sharma @ Arman S/o Sanjiv Kumar is admitted on bail on furnishing bail bonds in sum of Rs. 20,000/ with one surety in the like amount with an undertaking not to temper with the evidence of the prosecution and to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing and not to leave the country without prior permission of the Court. Requisite bail bonds bonds and surety bonds furnished today which are accepted and attested. Ahlmad of this Court is directed to retain the file and put the same as and when the application for furnishing the bail bonds and surety bonds is moved by applicant. Papers be sent back to the concerned immediately.
