Challan presented today. It be checked and registered. Accused produced in custody along with challan under Section 141 of the Railways Act. Copies of challan supplied to the accused free of costs in compliance of Section 207 Cr.P.C. From the perusal of the police report a prima facie punishable under Section 141 of the Railways Act, 1989 is made out against the accused to which he has pleaded guilty and has not claimed trial. The accused has suffered a confessional statement. Statement appears to be voluntary and free from any coercion or undue from any quarter. Keeping in view the plea of guilt of accused, the accused is hereby convicted under Section 141 Railway Act. In view of the confessional statement made by the accused, I am of the considered view that the ends of justice would be met if the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- u/s 141 Railway Act. Fine paid. The accused be released from custody if not required in any other case. File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
