An application under section 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) is filed by the petitioners namely, **1. Bikash Das @ Bikas Kumar Das** and **2. Mrinmayee Das** who apprehend arrest in connection with **Sagar P.S Case No. 166/2026 dated 16.06.2026 under section 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/118(1)/ 118(2)//109/74/351(3)/3(5) BNS** is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the petitioners/accused submits that no such application u/s. 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) is either rejected or pending before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused/petitioners submits that the accused /petitioners are completely innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. As such, he prayed for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioners.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge produces the case diary and raises objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) of the present accused/petitioners.

Learned advocate for de facto complainant appearing by filing vokalatnama also raises objection against anticipatory bail of accused /petitioners.

Heard both the sides.

I have perused the instant application, the case diary and other materials on record including injury report.

It appears that alleged incident occurred on 15.06.2026. Victim has already been treated and discharged from the hospital. The materials available available in case diary do not indicate the necessity of custodial interrogation of the present accused/petitioners. **Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec.438 Cr.PC.) of the petitioners/accused is allowed.**

The petitioners/accused, in the event of arrest, shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of **Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2500/- each**, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the compliance of the condition as laid down in sec. 482(2) B.N.S.S., 2023 (sec.438(2) Cr.PC.).

Thus, the Crl. Misc. Case is disposed of.
