Pleadings are complete in this case. Following issues arise out of the pleadings—

- 1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to a recovery of Rs.4,00,000/- , as prayed for in prayer (A) ? OPP*
- 2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to interest, if yes, at what rate and for what period ? OPP*
- 3. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to a decree of permanent injunction, as prayed for in prayer (B) ? OPP*
- 4. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to a decree of permanent injunction to disconnect the electricity connection of sub meter, as prayed for in prayer (C) ? OPP*
- 5. Relief.*

No other issue arises or is pressed for. List of witnesses be filed by parties within 14 days. Evidence by way of affidavit be supplied atleast 30 days in advance to the other side.
