The plaintiffs filed this suit for Partition and Separate possession against the defendants.

The Plaintiffs No.1 has filed an applications U/o.32 Rule 7 of CPC with certificate and submits that the plaintiffs filed this suit for Partition and Separate Possession against the defendants in respect of suit schedule properties. The present application is concerned to appointment of guardian of Plaintiff No.2 as the present Plaintiff No.1 is Smt. Padmavati W/o Shubash Khot is natural guardian and mother of Plaintiff No.2 as the Plaintiff No.2 has not completed 18 years of age and the Plaintiff No.1 has no interest in the matter in controversy in the suit adverse that of interest of the minor Plaintiff No.2. Therefore, the Plaintiff No.1 Smt. Padmavati W/o Shubash Khot is fit and proper person to be appointed as guardian of Plaintiff No.2 Accordingly, I pass the following:

ORDER

The application filed U/O.32 Rule 7 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The Plaintiff No.1 Smt. Padmavati W/o Shubash Khot mother of Plaintiff No.2) is appointed as a guardian of Plaintiff No.2.

conditions agreed by both the parties in respect of the compromise are found to be genuine and lawful.

Therefore, the compromise petition filed by both the parties U/o.23 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby accepted. Accordingly, this court/forum proceed to pass the following:

Office is hereby directed to draw decree in terms of compromise petition.

Compromise petition shall be made part and parcel of the decree.
