ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

The present bail application is filed under section 483 of BNSS for the offence under sections 318(4), 319(2), 336(2), 336(2), 338, 340(2), 3(5) of BNS and S. 66(d) of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

2] It was submitted by the applicant that the complaint has been lodged at the instance of the informant. The allegations against the applicant are baseless. She is falsely implicated without any material evidence. The applicant is only the employee. There is no forgery committed on the part of the applicant. There is no direct link of the applicant with the crime. The I.O. had recovered the alleged articles. Her custody is not required for further investigation. The applicant is permanent resident of the address given in the FIR. She is ready to abide the conditions imposing on her. Hence application be allowed.

3] The investigating officer filed say through learned APP and opposed the application on the ground that if the

accused is released on bail, she might tamper with the prosecution. The investigation is in progress and the custody of the present accused would be required for confrontation with the other absconding accused. The offence is serious in nature. Hence, he should not be released on bail.

4] Heard learned advocate for applicant/accused and learned APP

5] The perusal of the FIR and bail application shows that the accused is in jail since 21/05/2026. The perusal of the allegations in the FIR shows that there is prima-facie involvement of the present accused in the offence. The accused is involved in the serious offence. The further investigation is in progress. If the accused is released on bail she might tamper with the prosecution evidence. Also she might hinder the investigation. It also seems that there are several offences registered against the accused in similar offences. There are chances that she might indulge in similar offences. The absconding accused is yet to be arrested and therefore, if the accused is released, she might pressurize the co-accused and prosecution witnesses. Since the investigation is in progress it would not appropriate to release her on bail. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER
