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**First bail application under Sec. 439 Cr.PC.**

**ORDER:**

1. By this order, this Court intends to dispose of the present bail application under section 439 Cr.PC having been filed by applicant Lakhbir Singh @ Bittu.

2. Notice of the bail application alongwith its copy was served upon the State through the Additional PP attached to this court who accepted the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. I have heard the respective submissions of both the sides and have also gone through the record.

4. Perusal of the police file shows that recovery of 150 intoxicant tablets was effected from the applicant and he is in custody since 17.05.2021 and the report from the office of FSL has not yet been received. In view of the ratio of Crl. Misc. no. 1389 of 2013 Ravinder Singh alias Rinku Vs. State of Punjab and Crl. Misc. No. 13 of 2012 Inder Singh Vs. Ladi decided on 31.1.2014, interim bail is granted to the applicant/accused on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court subject to the following conditions:

- A. That the applicant shall appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
- B. That the applicant shall not directly or indirectly induce or coerce any witness of prosecution so as to dissuade him from deposing as witness in the Court.

- C. That the applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- D. In addition to the above referred directions, in view of the outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19), the applicant is also directed to maintain social distancing and to obey the guidelines issued in this regard by the competent authorities during continuance of such outbreak.

In case, on receipt of the report of FSL, if the recovery of contraband is found to be falling within the ambit of commercial quantity as reflected in the schedule appended with NDPS Act on receipt of report of Chemical Examiner, the applicant shall surrender before this court and his interim bail shall be deemed to have been cancelled. With such directions this bail application stands disposed of. Police record be returned and the file of this bail application be attached with the remand papers.
