ORDER

1. An application for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR no. 14 dated 09.08.2025 Under Sections 85, 316 (2) of the BNS Police Station Women, Sangrur, has been filed on behalf of applicant-accused.
2. Upon notice, Sh. Yashdeep Bhardwaj, Addl. PP appeared on behalf of State and Sh. Balpreet Singh Ghuman, Advocate appeared on behalf of complainant.
3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant-accused

and learned Addl. PP for the State assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and have gone through the record.

4. Applicant-accused Harpreet Singh was admitted to interim bail vide order dated 02.09.2025 passed by this court, subject to condition that applicant-accused shall join the investigation within 03 days from that day. Today, ASI Gurdev Singh, no.1356/Sgr, posted at P.S. Women Sangrur has made a statement in the court that the applicant-accused Harpreet Singh has joined the investigation on 05.09.2025 and he has not got recovered the vehicle i.e. car, so accused/applicant is required for further custodial interrogation. Learned Addl. PP for the State has submitted that applicant-accused has not got recovered the car. So, the bail application of the applicant-accused be dismissed.

5. Perusal of record reveals that applicant in compliance of the order dated 02.09.2025 passed by this court has joined the investigation. Applicant is none other, but husband of complainant's sister-in-law (Nandoi). The allegations against him is that he has given the vehicle and has also arranged for the accommodation of Gurdeep Singh and Atinderpal Kaur. The counsel for the applicant-accused has submitted that applicant/accused has not provided any car to the complainant's husband and he cannot be compelled to produce any such car, which he never provided to complainant's husband. Perusal of FIR reveals that in the FIR there is no mention of any car, its make and its registration number, which is alleged to be provided by applicant to the complainant's husband. Further the alleged car is not a dowry article, which is to be recovered

from the applicant/accused. So keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the interim order dated 02.09.2025 passed by this court, vide which accused-applicant was admitted to interim bail is made absolute and stands confirmed. Thus, bail application is allowed. Applicant-accused shall also comply with the following provision of Section 482 (2) Cr.P.C :-

1. That the applicant-accused will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.

2. That the applicant-accused will not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the court.
