

BA CIS No.3094 of 2018 Ashwani Kumar Versus State of Unjab

ORDER

This order shall dispose of an application filed by the applicant Ashwani Kumar for grant of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.276 dated 21.07.2018 under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Zirakpur.

2. It has been averred in the application that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the case as he has not committed any offence. He has been arrested in the case on 30.07.2018 and is in custody since then. Allegations levelled in the F.I.R. are false. No previous incident has been mentioned in the F.I.R. which has only been registered simply for the reason that the sister of the complainant committed suicide. The relationship between the applicant and deceased were cordial. The applicant was unaware about the incident. He was at his work place in Industrial Area, Phase-1, Panchkula. Accused Babita alongwith her husband was in Max Hospital where her son was admitted. Even co-accused Sri Kant was in Uttar Pradesh at that time. F.I.R. is nothing but just a tactic to harass and humiliate the applicant alongwith other members of his family.

3. Allegations levelled in the F.I.R. are that the applicant/accused alongwith members of his family was harassing and humiliating the deceased and used to tease her by saying illiterate. She was also maltreated on account of not giving birth to a male child.

4. Since the allegations against the applicant are serious in nature. The case is at the initial stage. In case the applicant is released on bail, there is every possibility that he may tamper with the investigation or influence the witnesses. Therefore, finding no ground for grant of concession of regular bail, his application is hereby dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
