ORDER:

1. The instant bail application has been filed under section 439 Cr.P.C.,
praying for grant of regular bail to the accused/applicant in case FIR
No.39 dated 08.05.2019 under section 452, 354, 323, 148, 149, 201
IPC, registered at police station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar.
2. As per version of applicant, he is quite innocent and has been falsely
implicate in the present case. The accused/applicant is behind the bars
since 02.06.2019. Moreover, complainant and his associates attacked
on Varinder Kumar and Sonia (co-accused) who sustained injury and
they were medically examined at Civil Hospital Jalandhar on
08.05.2019 and to this effect MLRs were also prepared by the

concerned doctor. Both Raj Rani and Sonia (co-accused) were also granted interim bail by this Court. No recovery has been effected from the present applicant. His custodial interrogation is not required. Challan has not been presented till today. It is prayed that applicant may be released on bail.

3. The accused/applicant is in custody since 02.06.2019. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in custody for indefinite period. Challan has not been presented before the Court till today, which is likely to take time. In view of these factual circumstances, the bail application of the accused/applicant succeeds and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing the bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:

- a) That he will not tamper with the prosecution evidence and will not offer any threat, promise or inducement, directly or indirectly to any of the person acquainted with the facts of the case, dissuading them from disclosing the same to the court/investigating agency; and
- b) That he will not leave the limits of India without prior permission of the Court.
- c) That he will come present in trial court on each and every date of hearing subject to exemption granted by the trial court.
- d) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.

Nothing observed herein shall have any bearing upon the merits of the case and shall confine its effect only to the disposal of

the present bail application. Let trial Court's report be called for

28.08.2019. Bail application papers be consigned to the record-room.
