Once again, adjournment sought on behalf of petitioner stating that main counsel is not available today. The record shows that too many opportunities have been given to the petitioner but pain has not been taken to even file the written submissions. Mr. Tripathi submits that even the respondent does not want to file any written submissions. This is the stand taken despite taking opportunity for such purpose on the last date. This is apparent that adjournment was taken by both the parties without being sincere to their words.

This conduct of both the parties is not appreciated. Strict warning is being recorded for both the parties and next time, this Court shall be compelled to impose heavy penalty on both the parties. Once they were given directions to file brief note of their submissions, it was no more an option for them. Hence, a cost of Rs. 2,000/- is imposed upon both the parties to be deposited in NDBA Members Welfare Fund, Account No. 18580110013847, IFSC Code UCBA0001858 (UCO Bank, Patiala House Courts Branch, New Delhi). Deposit receipt must be filed upto to NDOH and written submission should also be filed upto the NDOH with advance copy supplied to the opposite party.
