

Kamaljit Kaur etc Versus State. BA No.7187 of 2019.
(CNR No. PBHO01-011909-2019).

Present: Shri J.B.S Gill, Counsel for applicants-accused.

Bail application presented before me today being Duty Judge, during winter spell. Heard. Applicants are seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183 dated 19.12.2019, under Sections 498-A & 406 of IPC, pertaining to Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur. It is pleaded that the applicants are mother-in-law and sister-in-law of the complainant. Learned Counsel for the applicants has referred the FIR and argued that there are no specific allegations against the applicants. Even applicant No.2 Ramandeep is married for more than 8 years and this fact has not been mentioned by the complainant in her complaint. Moreover, complainant and her husband are living separately and this fact is also mentioned in Para No.7 of the complaint. The applicants are having apprehension of their arrest. In view of these circumstances, the applicants-accused Kamaljit Kaur and Ramandeep are directed to join the investigation before the I.O/arresting officer within 5 days from today and in case of their doing so, they will be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal bail bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- each with one surety of the like amount each to the satisfaction of arresting officer/I.O subject to compliance of conditions enshrined in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Notice to State be issued and file be put up on 3.1.2020 before Learned Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur for its entrustment.
