- 1. Whether Plaintiffs have suppressed the material facts? OPDs**
- 2. Whether the deceased father of parties bequeathed the suit property in favour of the plaintiffs through Will dated 11.09.2021? OPP**
- 3. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for decree of possession of suit property, as prayed for in Prayer Clause (a)? OPP**
- 4. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for decree of mandatory injunction, as prayed for in Prayer Clause (b)? OPP**

5. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for decree of permanent injunction, as prayed for in Prayer Clause (c)? OPP

6. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for damages/mesne profits? If so, at what rate and for which period?

7. Relief.
