ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of regular bail application filed by the applicant in above said FIR.
2. The factual matrix of the present case as unfurled from the FIR is that FIR is registered on the application moved by complainant Nitin Kumar who has stated that present applicant is his friend and due to

some misunderstanding they have stopped communication. On 19.02.2021 at about 08:45 p.m. he was standing outside his house where present applicant alongwith Ginni Pehalwan came on Innova car bearing no.MH-02EU-3773 and started abusing him and threatened him. Then he came to Mandi Gobindgarh Bus stand on his car with his friend Paras Sharma where present applicant alongwith some unknown person were coming on a motorcycle bearing no.PB-11-AS-9343 which was hit by some unknown vehicle and he was present there where he was given beatings and threats and fled from the spot after leaving the above said motorcycle. Later on the registration number of said motorcycle was found to be forged. Hence, the present FIR.

3. Upon notice, Ld.Addl.PP for the State appeared and contested the bail application.
4. Ex facie, Ld. Counsel for the applicant has argued that present applicant is in custody since 11.03.2021. Nothing is to be recovered from him. All the offences are bailable except 473 & 411 Indian Penal Code.
5. Record requisitioned and perused.
6. Perusal of the record shows that there was some dispute between the complainant and present applicant who are neighbors and on two occasions present applicant threatened and abused the complainant

and also criminally assaulted him. Recovery of motorcycle as well as car has been effected. The allegations regarding forgery of registration no of motorcycle can only be proved during trial. Nothing is to be recovered from him. He is in custody. No purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars. In the present set of circumstances, bail application in hand stands allowed. Bail applicant is directed to furnish bail bonds and surety bonds of Rs.50,000/- with one surety alike amount before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate and in that event trial/Duty Magistrate should release him on bail to its own satisfaction. With these observations, application in hand stands disposed off. Police record be returned. Bail file be consigned to records.
