Today is fixed for disposal on merit.

No steps taken by either side.

It appears from the order sheet that order dated 06.03.2026 (followed by order No.16 dated 15.12.2025) and order No. 07.07.2026 were inadvertently numbered as 60 and 61 respectively instead of 17 and 18. The Bench Clerk is directed to make necessary corrections.

It appears that the present appeal was filed u/s.29 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act for setting aside the impugned order dated 12.05.2022 passed by the Ld. J.M., 2nd Court in Case No. C- 476/2020 whereby the prayer of the appellant was allowed exparte and the respondent therein was directed to pay monetary relief of Rs. 5000/- per month to the appellant from the date of filing of that case.

The aggrieved lady (the appellant herein) preferred this Appeal on the ground of insufficiency of the award passed by the Ld. Magistrate pointing out that the respondent Anish Bagchi was earning Rs. 2,00,000/- per month. The appellant did not file any document as proof of income of the respondent. It also appears that the LCR was not sent to this Court inspite of repeated reminders. So, in the absence of the LCR and relevant documents it cannot be decided whether the monetary relief awarded by the Ld. Magistrate in the impugned order was insufficient.

Although the instant appeal cannot be decided on merit, considering the conduct of the appellant who failed to take any steps in this matter since long, I am not inclined to keep this appeal pending any further.

The instant appeal is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
