1. Applicant has filed an application under Section 24 of C.P.C. for seeking transfer of the execution case bearing No. Ex.A 01/2023 pending in the Court of XIII Civil Judge Senior Division Indore and MJC No. 919/2019 pending in the Court of XIX Civil Judge Senior Division Indore to one Court.

2. The facts of the application in brief are that the Ex.A 01/2023 is pending in the Court of XIII Civil Judge Senior Division Indore, while MJC No. 919/2019 is pending in the

Court of XIX Civil Judge Senior Division Indore. Applicant has seeks transfer of aforesaid both the cases in one Court on the grounds that aforesaid both the cases have arisen out of original judgment/decreed dated 14-10-2019 passed by X Civil Judge Senior Division Indore in RCSA 80/2013. Therefore, both the cases should be heard and decided by one Court. Hence, it has been prayed that both the cases be transferred in on Court. Applicant has filed an affidavit in support of transfer application.

Point for determination

3. Whether the grounds taken by applicant in the application u/s. 24 of CPC are reasonable, sufficient and bona fide and application is deserve to allowed ?

4. From a perusal of aforesaid both the cases, it is revealed that original judgment/decreed dated 14-10-2019 passed by X Civil Judge Senior Division Indore in RCSA 80/2013. Non-applicant has filed execution for the execution of said judgment/decreed, while applicant has filed an application under Order 09 rule 13 CPC for set assiding the aforesaid judgment/decreed which has been registered as MJC No. 919/2019. It is clear that above MJC and execution case have arisen out of same judgment/decreed. Therefore aforesaid both the cases should be heard and decided by one Court.

5. Resultantly, having considered all the facts and circumstances, application u/s. 24 of CPC is allowed. Ex.A 01/2023 which is pending in the Court of XIII Civil Judge Senior Division Indore is withdrawn from that Court and transferred to the Court of XIX Civil Judge Senior Division Indore for disposal in accordance with law.

6. A copy of order be sent to the concerning Courts for information/compliance.
