ORDER

1. Heard on the bail application dated 13.11.2025 through learned counsel on the basis of power of attorney executed by the accused/applicant namely Sahil Batta alongwith affidavit of Rekha, the wife of the applicant-accused.
2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State through Ld. Addl. PP, who put in appearance and contested bail application. He didn't file any reply to the bail application rather submitted that he will orally argue the matter. The File was requisitioned.

3. I have heard Ld. Addl. PP for the State and Ld. Counsel for bail-applicant and have gone through the police record.

4. From material placed on record, it comes out to surface that the accused Sahil Batta was apprehended on 27.03.2025 with 48 intoxicant tablets having salt Alprazolam. After completing the necessary formalities, the FIR was registered. In the present case, the applicant/accused was declined bail vide order dated 16.05.2025 as the accused was stated to have 06 FIRs against him.

6. The challan was presented and the charge was framed on 11.11.2025 as the FSL report was received which shows the quantity to be non-commercial. Now the case is fixed for 18.12.2025 for evidence of the prosecution. Bail is a rule and Jail is an exception. This Court deems it proper to grant bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with the following conditions:

- a) That accused shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing;
- b) That accused shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he/she is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he/she is suspected;
- c) That accused shall not directly or indirectly make an inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence; and

- d) That accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of Court.

7. The observation made by undersigned vide this order shall not be construed as reflection of mind on merits. Bail application file be attached with the main case file.
