

State Vs. Sahil & Anr. SC-1087-2019

Present : Ms. Manjinder Kaur, Addl. PP for State.
 Accused Sahil on bail, represented by Sh. G.S. Grewal, Adv.
 Accused Sunny Verma (since died).

Today, the case is fixed for prosecution evidence but no prosecution witness is present. Perusal of record reveals that prosecution has availed as many as 33 effective opportunities including today's one but the prosecution has failed to conclude its evidence despite availing number of effective opportunities. The prosecution is requested for one more adjournment for the same purpose. There is no justification to adjourn the case further for evidence of prosecution. Hence, the evidence of prosecution is hereby closed by order.

Statement of accused under section 313 CrPC has been recorded to which he opted not to lead evidence in his defence.

Arguments heard. Vide my separate detailed judgment of even date, the accused Sahil has been acquitted of the charges framed against him. He is directed to furnish personal bonds in the sum of Rupees 50,000/-. The requisite personal bonds have been furnished which are accepted and attested. Case property, if any, be disposed off after expiry of period of appeal or revision, if any. File be consigned to the Record Room.
