They are, accordingly, acquitted from this offence as well as this case U/s 255(1) Cr.P.C. they be set at liberty at once.

The sureties are discharged from their respective bail-bonds.

Seized alamats, if any, be disposed off according to law after expiry of the period of appeal.

The victim has the right to prefer an appeal against this Judgment and order of acquittal in terms of proviso of Section 372 of the Cr.P.C and to avail free legal aid service as per entitlement and let a copy of this order be forwarded to District Magistrate and Chairman SDLSA in terms of the decision of Hon’ble High Court at Calcutta dated 29.03.2022 in Sabitri Bhunya vs. State of West Bengal and others (CRA 266 OF 2020/ CRAN 1 of 2020).
