Police record not produced. Reply not filed. However, Ld APP for the state orally contested the bail application. As per the affidavit of Balbir Singh who is uncle of applicant, the present application is first bail application of the applicant and no such or similar bail application is pending or decided by any court.

2. Arguments heard. The perusal of the file shows that the present FIR no.146 dated 26.11.2024, PS Sadar Patti has been registered against the present applicant and other for the offence under section 281, 125, 324(4), 74 BNS on the allegations that on 25.11.2024 while driving tractor trolley in question caused accident with swift car bearing no.PB 05 AS 9473 being driven by complainant Harpreet Singh s/o Baldev Singh r/o Village Muthiawala and also torn the shirt of his wife.

The present applicant was arrested on 25.11.2024 and was produced before the court on 26.11.2024 and as only judicial remand was sought, so he was sent to the judicial custody vide order dated 26.11.2024 and since then he is behind the bars.

Therefore, by considering the allegations against the accused and custody already undergone by him, I find that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars for any further period especially when completion of investigation and conclusion of trial may take reasonably long time.

In view of my above discussion, the present application is allowed in the manner that the applicant is hereby admitted on bail for the offence under section 281, 125, 324(4), 74 BNS subject to furnishing personal bail bonds for an amount of Rs.50000/-. Hence, the present application stands disposed of.

3 Necessary bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Ahlmad is directed to send the soft copy of this order to the concerned Jail Superintendent through official email id today itself for delivering the same to the applicant/accused. Papers be tagged with the remand papers of present case.
