ORDER

1. By this order, this Court intends to dispose of the present bail application under section 483 of BNSS filed by the applicant/accused Sohan Singh.
2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP attached to this court alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Record was also requisitioned which has been received and perused.
3. I have heard the respective submissions of both the sides and carefully gone through the file.

4. The ld. Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the name of applicant is not mentioned in the FIR but has been impleaded on the basis of supplementary statement recorded by the complainant on 11.8.2024 after gap of 39 days which is an afterthought and the complainant has failed to explain how and what manner he came to know about the name of the applicant. That no injury has been attributed upon the applicant. That the applicant is in judicial custody since 11.8.2024 and he is no longer required for further investigation. That as the challan has been presented in the court. Therefore, he has prayed that he be granted regular bail.

5. On the other hand learned Additional PP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that the applicant alongwith his companions is alleged to have fired gun shots injuries upon the complainant and his companions resulting in gun shot upon their persons. And that due to the serious nature of accusations he does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

6. From the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Additional PP for the State, I am of the considered view that after framing of charge, statement of complainant Gurjinder Singh as well as two other injured witnesses namely Satnam Singh and Sonu have already been examined. That all the three witnesses did not support the prosecution's case and were declared hostile. That as the complainant and other two injured witnesses have not supported the case of prosecution and have specifically deposed that they do not identify

the accused/applicant as an culprit, who fired upon them and caused injuries to them. That the applicant is in judicial custody since 11.8.2024 i.e. more than one year and the challan has also been produced in the court. Accordingly, the bail application of applicant-accused filed under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Trial Court/ Illaqa/Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions :-

- A. That the applicant shall appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
- B. That the applicant shall not directly or indirectly induce or coerce any witness of prosecution so as to dissuade him from deposing as witness in the Court.
- C. That the applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

Intimation of the bail granted to the applicant be sent to the concerned Superintendent jail through E-mail. Police record be returned and the file of this bail application be attached with the remand papers/challan file.
