ORDER BELOW EXH.26.

Instant application is filed by the applicant for grant of permission to lead his evidence. It is contended that the adjournment application was filed by the applicant on the ground that the applicant could not remain present before the Court, however, it was rejected and fixed the matter for dismissal order. The applicant is present before the Court and ready to adduce his evidence, hence, prayed to set aside the said order.

02. Say is given by the non-applicants on the backside of the said application and strongly opposed it and prayed to reject it.

03. Heard from both the sides.

04. Perused the record and proceedings, it appears that the application (Exh.1) is filed for restoration of the suit under Order-IX Rule-9 of the CPC. Record further appears that the applicant failed to adduce his evidence, as such, the adjournment application filed on 17.04.2026 by the applicant was rejected. Thereafter, instant application (Exh.26) is filed.

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of his contention for restoration of the suit. Hence, I pass following order:

02. The applicant is directed to adduce his evidence, on next date, positively.
03. No further adjournment will be granted.
