**Order Below Exh. 01 in Succession
Application No. 56/2026.**

(PUNAM VISHAL POL Vs. NOBODY)

This is an application filed by the applicant nos. 1 to 3 for issuance succession certificate under the provisions of section 372 of The Indian Succession Act, 1925.

2. It is the case of the applicants that deceased Vishal Vitthal Pol was husband of applicant no. 1. Applicant no. 2 and 3 are children of deceased Vishal and applicant no.1. Vishal Pol died on 29.01.2026. He was working with Satara Nagar Parishad as sweeper. Satara Nagar Parishad issued letter to the applicant and asked her to furnish succession certificate for claiming benefit. Hence, this application.

3. Paper notice and citation published in daily “Dainik Tarun Bharat” dated 17.05.2026, calling upon the objections from the public at large. However, no one come forward and raised objection.

4. Applicant led her evidence vide Exh. 10. She deposed as per application. Applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Vishal Vitthal Pol.

5. Applicant has also filed the documents vide list Exh. 3 and 11. The paper publication notice (Exh.11/1) and proclamation (Exh.9). However, no objection received. Thus, the evidence on record shows that, the applicants are the only legal heirs of the deceased Vishal Vitthal Pol. Therefore, all applicants are entitled to

get heir-ship certificate in favour of applicant no. 1 as prayed. In the result, following order.

- ORDER -

1. The application is allowed.
2. Issue succession certificate in favour of the applicant no. 1.
3. Applicants to pay requisite court fees as per the provisions of law, if any.
