2. FSL report has yet not been received on record. IO submits that the FSL result in the present matter is not yet ready. Issue notice to the SHO concerned to take requisite steps for expediting the FSL Result as per the status report received from FSL and to file the same on record, on or before NDOH.
3. Ld. Addl. Substitute PP has submitted that accused Ajju has violated the condition no. 3 of the bail order dated 09.01.2024 and now he is in JC in similar case lodged vide FIR NO. 157/2023, U/s. 341/34/307 IPC and 25 Arms Act PS Nand Nagri; that the present case is also for the similar offence i.e. offence punishable under Section 307 IPC, therefore, bail of the accused in the present case be cancelled.

5. Ld. Counsel for accused is directed to file written reply or address verbal arguments or submissions on the issue that as to why bail of the accused in the present matter be not cancelled due to alleged violation of condition No.3 of bail order dated 09.01.2024 vide

which accused was enlarged on bail in the present case.
