Bail application is taken up today through video conferencing by using 'CISCO Webex' App. during Covid-19 Pandemic in compliance of order No.1/RG/DHC/2022 dt. 12.01.2022 issued by Hon'ble High Court & order no. 207-230/Judl/SHD/2022, Dt.14.01.2022 issued by Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Shahdara, Delhi.

Ms. Alka Singh, Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused (through video conferencing).

IO/SI Kiran Pal has also joined video conferencing.
Reply is filed.

This is an application for grant of interim bail for a period of one month u/s. 439 Cr.P.C as filed on behalf of above named applicant/accused.

Arguments have been heard through video conferencing using 'Cisco WebEx' App.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused argued that marriage of

sister of applicant (daughter of Bua) namely Afsana is to be solemnized on 06.02.2022 and presence of applicant being elder brother in the family is required to perform certain rituals i.e Bhaat etc. It has been submitted that another brother of applicant is residing in Chennai and he has no concern with the family. It is thus prayed that applicant be granted interim bail for a period of one month so that he can make arrangement and participate in the marriage of his cousin.

Per contra, interim bail application is opposed by Ld. Addl. PP for the State while arguing that applicant has three uncles and one another brother namely Abrar, who can make arrangement and participate in the rituals, if any. It is submitted that there are no sufficient grounds for granting interim bail to the applicant.

As per report of IO, applicant has one another brother and three uncles, who can make arrangement of marriage of his cousin.

After considering the rival submissions, I am not inclined to grant interim bail to the applicant/accused. Interim bail application accordingly stands dismissed.
