Two weeks' time period was given to respondents on 11.02.2026 for filing of the replies to two applications of Ms. Pushpa Gaur, wife of revisionist ; (1) one application was for information of death of revisionist on 13.10.2025 with a copy of death certificate ; (2) second application was for permission to continue with revision petition after death of revisionist.

Nothing of the sort was done by respondents in given time period.

Ld. Counsel for the respondent no. 2 and 3 has placed on record today belatedly the reply of respondent no. 2 and 3 to the application for seeking permission to continue with the revision petition. Copy was given.

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: 2 :

Respondent No. 1 / State did not file reply to any of the applications of Ms. Pushpa Gaur, wife of revisionist, in given time period or later till today.

Copy of this order be sent to Director of Prosecution to ensure filing of the reply to the application of Ms. Pushpa Gaur, wife of the revisionist seeking permission to continue with the revision petition after death of the revisionist ; within one week time period of receipt of copy of the order.

How is the aforesaid application of Ms. Pushpa Gaur, wife of revisionist within period of limitation ?

How in the absence of other legal heirs of deceased revisionist, only the applicant wife can maintain the revision petition after the death of revisionist ?

Brief written submissions not exceeding three pages on above facets be filed by the parties to the *Iis* in one week time period.
