

The petitioner and respondent no.2 counsel filed the joint memo stating that the matter is amicably settled. As per settlement, 2nd respondent agreed to deposit Rs.6,60,000/-. Petitioners are agreed for the said amount.

Joint memo is duly signed by the parties and their respective counsels. Perused the joint memo. Compromise entered is lawful. Hence satisfied, joint memo is accepted and proceed to pass the following;

:: ORDER ::

Petition is allowed in terms of joint memo filed by the parties. Petitioner is entitled to receive the compensation amount of Rs.6,60,000/-.

After deposit of the compensation amount Rs. 1,10,000/- shall be kept in fixed deposit in the name of the petitioner for a period of two years in any Nationalized or Scheduled Bank of his choice with liberty to withdraw interest and balance amount of Rs.5,50,000/- shall be released to the petitioner through E-payment.

Joint memo shall be the part and parcel of this order.

Draw an award accordingly.
