It is true to suggest that I and petitioner were working together. It is false to suggest that at the time of accident, I was not there. It is true to suggest that at the time of accident, I and petitioner were working under Respondent no.4 in the house of Respondent no.1. It is true to suggest that we were not working under Respondent no.2 & 3 at the time of accident.

2. Prior to accident, Respondent no.1 & 4 have informed the Respondent no.2 & 3 about disconnection of electric connection. We informed for disconnection of electricity to our mason Ramakrishnappa as well as Thimmarayappa. It is false to suggest that neither Respondent no.1 nor Respondent no.4 had given any letter to Respondent no.2 & 3 to disconnect the Electricity. I did not see the letter, however, Respondent no.1 & 4 and Thimmarayappa had given information to the said letter. I can't produce the said letter to this court.

3. It is false to suggest that incident occurred solely negligence on the part of Respondent no.1 & 4 and not on the part of Respondent no.2 & 3. It is false to suggest that in order to help the petitioner, I came before the court to give false

evidence on behalf of the petitioner. It is false to suggest that the Respondent no.2 & 3 are not held liable to pay compensation to the petitioner.

Further cross examination by advocate for Respondent no.4:-

Whatever statement I deposed before in CC 33485/2022 is true and correct. The witness admitted his signature in the deposition hence the said deposition is marked as Ex.R-5.
