ORDER

1. SI Mandeep Singh No. 265 Kapurthala (C) is present along with record. Arguments heard. It is argued by Id. Counsel for accused-applicant that on the vague and wild allegations, present false case has been registered against the accused and now, he is in custody from the date of his arrest i.e. 03.10.22. So, prayed to admit her on regular bail.

2. On the other hand, Id. Addl. PP has opposed this bail application on the ground that FIR of this case was registered on the complaint of Balwinder Singh Malri, President, Balmiki Sena, Punjab. It is the allegation of the complainant that Jasneet Kaur has uttered derogatory words, against the caste and SC community at large. So, the person who has hurt the feelings of very downtrodden of society and

created hatred in the society, does not deserve any leniency or concession of bail. Therefore, prayed for dismissal of her bail application.

3. After hearing ld. Counsel for the accused-applicant and ld. Addl.PP for the State, I am of the opinion that though, it is the allegation of the complainant that accused-applicant, who is Punjabi actor, can be heard on a video, on social media, while using derogatory words against the caste of particular person, by calling that person, 'Churra Chamar'. So, it has hurt their feelings. However, matter is under investigation and police has to present the challan, after verifying the facts of audio video of accused-applicant made viral on social media, while uttering derogatory remarks, against any person. Whereas, it will take time for the police to complete the investigation and then to present the challan but no purpose will be served by unnecessarily detaining the applicant in custody since 03.10.2022.

3. Therefore, her bail application is allowed. So, the accused-applicant is ordered to be released on bail, on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount. File be consigned to record room.
