1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to preliminary decree of partition qua property bearing no.F-96, Khanpur Village, Delhi-62, property no.C-12, Shiv Park, near Khanpur, Delhi and premise of Khanpur Temple, Khanpur Chauraha beside RPS Colony, MB Road, New Delhi-62 and other properties, if any, to the extent of 1/3rd share? OPP.
2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to final decree by metes and bounds of partition qua property bearing no.F-96, Khanpur Village, Delhi-62, property no.C-12, Shiv Park, near Khanpur, Delhi and premise of Khanpur Temple, Khanpur Chauraha beside RPS Colony, MB Road, New Delhi-62 and other properties, if any, to the extent of 1/3rd share? OPP.

3. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to permanent injunction restraining the defendants from create any third party in the abovementioned properties. OPP.
4. Whether the defendant no.2 is the absolute owner of the property no.C-12, Shiv Park, near Khanpur, Delhi and the same is self acquired property of defendant no.2 ? OPD2.
5. Whether the properties bearing no.F-96, Khanpur Village, Delhi-62 and premise of Khanpur Temple, Khanpur Chauraha beside RPS Colony, MB Road, New Delhi-62 belong to the father of the plaintiff and form the ancestral property? OPP.
6. Relief.
