One opportunity was granted to the convict on the LDOH on his statement that he shall be making a payment of Rs. 1 Lakh to the complainant company by way of demand draft today in court towards settlement. Despite the opportunity the convict has yet again failed to honour his statement given in the court. In these circumstances, the opportunity granted to the convict for making payment as aforementioned and for considering the present case for referral to National Lok Adalat stands closed.

Perusal of the record reveals that the present case is one of the oldest cases in this court and convict had earlier settled the present case qua civil liability for an amount of Rs.3.80 Lakh and had agreed to clear the payment in two installments within four months starting from 05.06.2026, however, the convict failed to make any payment whatsoever till date.

Thereafter, the convict failed to appear before this court and BWs had to be issued to secure his presence before this court.

Convict appeared on the LDOH and submitted that he is not in a position to make the payment of settlement amount of Rs.3.80 Lakhs and requested it to be lowered. It is pertinent to mention here that the

settlement amount of Rs.3.80 Lakh was already approved by the complainant company. Thereafter, one opportunity was granted by this court on the LDOH to the convict to make payment of Rs. 1 Lakh to the complainant by way of DD and subject to the said payment, for referring the matter to the Lok Adalat.

However, despite opportunity convict has yet again failed to make payment towards settlement. It is clear from the conduct of the ocnvict that he has no intention of making any payment towards settlement in this case and is merely delaying the present case from proceeding further. This is one of the oldest cases pending in this court and judgment of conviction has already been passed. Despite that, convict moved an application under Section 311 Cr. P.C for recalling of defence witness which is pending disposal.

Arguments on the said application have been heard.

Re-list for orders on application filed under Section 311 Cr. P.C as well as for further proceedings on 24.08.2026.
