This Crl.M.P. having been finally heard on 20.10.2022 and the
Court on 21.10.2022 passed the following :

ORDER

The above numbered petition is for pre-arrest bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. Petitioner is the sole accused in Crime No.1412/2022 of Pampady Police Station. The offence alleged against the petitioner is punishable under Sec.498A of the Indian Penal Code.

3. This matter on being referred for mediation, stands amicably settled between the parties and the Mediator filed report along with the terms of settlement entered into by the parties. In the above circumstance, this Court, with the view that, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, is inclined to allow this petition, subject to conditions.

In the result, the petition stands allowed as follows:

- (1) In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on executing bail bond for ₹25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only), with two solvent sureties, each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

- (2) He shall co-operate with the investigation and shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required by him in writing to do so.
- (3) He shall not interfere with the investigation, nor shall he influence or threaten any witness or destroy or tamper with any evidence.
- (4) Violation of any of the conditions stipulated above would result in the cancellation of this Order granting pre-arrest bail.
