An application moved on behalf of applicant/accused Sahil Gupta for cancellation of his NBWs.

Heard. Perused.

In view of contents of the abovesaid application, NBWs issued against accused Sahil Gupta stands cancelled subject to fine of Rs. 500/-. Fine deposited. **The abovesaid application is disposed off.**

Dr. Chittranjan Behera, Professor, Forensic Medicine, AIIMS Hospital has appeared and has submitted that Dr. Deepak Prakash has already left the services of the hospital. However, Dr. Chitranjan Behera has not produced authority letter in his favour as he had appeared as a witness on the last date of hearing. Therefore, issue fresh summons to Medical Superintendent to depute another doctor who can identify the signatures of Dr. Deepak Prakash to depose in the Court on the NDOH.

Dr. Chitranjan Behera is hereby discharged.

Summons issued to PW Dr. Naveen Kumar received back unserved with the report 'no such doctor'.

Issue fresh summons to the said witness through MS, Batra Hospital alongwith copy of medical documents for NDOH.

PW-10 ACP Mukesh Kumar Jain is examined, cross examined on behalf of accused Sahil Gupta, Arun and Prakash and cross examination

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on behalf of accused Shiv Kumar is Nil. Opportunity is given and discharged.

Issue summons to witness mentioned at serial no. 13, 14 and 22 in the list of witnesses for NDOH.
