This is an application u/s 483 BNSS for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of accused Lalnunchami.

Reply to the bail application filed. Same is perused.

The interim bail was granted to the applicant on medical grounds as she was suffering from a skin problem and Ld. Counsel for applicant sought extension of the interim bail and in support relied upon the prescription issued by a Skin Clinic as per which the applicant was suggested 06 sessions of IPL light at an interval of 3-4 weeks vide prescription dated 02.03.2026, meaning thereby the next session of the applicant is after 04 weeks. Thus, no ground for extension of interim bail as on date is made out. Accordingly, **the interim bail application of accused Lalnunchami is dismissed.**

The application is disposed off accordingly.

As per the reply filed by the DRI, the surety furnished a copy of FDR as surety bond. However, as per report of DRI, the said FDR has been closed on the very day on which it was furnished before this court on 18.02.2026 without intimation to this Court, though it was tendered before this Court as a surety. In these circumstances, since as on date, there is no solvency proof on record and the solvency proof furnished by the surety has already been closed, the surety bond stands forfeited. **Issue warrant of**

attachment to the tune of the surety amount against the surety for the next date.

Issue NBW against accused and notice to his surety for the next date with direction to IO to make atleast three endeavours in case of non execution of the process and to file the report alongwith the relevant DD entries made in this regard.
