ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

1. Parties to the suit, specially complainant is present before the Court and he has filed compromise statement to the effect that the mutual agreement has settled down between them and no further litigation is desirous on the part of the complainant, so the matter may be disposed off by way of compounding of offences. After taking into consideration all the facts, stated in the settlement pursis and the law applicable thereto, it is just and reasonable to dispose of the case as per provision contained u/s. 320 of Cr.P.C. by way of compounding of offences. Hence, this matter is hereby disposed as compounded and accused is hereby acquitted from all the charges leveled in this case as per provision of sec. 320(8) of Cr.P.C.

2. The merits of the case do not want any further order for imposing cost to any of the parties, so there is no order as to cost.
