Arguments heard.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners that the main case i.e. civil suit filed by the respondent herein / plaintiff therein against the petitioners herein / defendants therein bearing CS SCJ No. 184/2025 titled as *Jarnail Singh Chopra v. Dr. Seema Bhagat & Anr* is pending in the Court of Ld. Civil Judge-04 (West), THC, Delhi. It is further submitted that the petitioners herein have filed a counter claim against the said main case bearing Counter Claim No. 19/2025 titled as *Dr. Seema Bhagat & Anr. v. Jarnail Singh Chopra* which is also pending in the Court of Ld. Civil Judge-04 (West), THC, Delhi. It is further submitted that the counter claim is valued at Rs. 4,74,300/- which is beyond the pecuniary jurisdiction of the Ld. Civil Judge and thus it is prayed that both the above mentioned suit and the counter claim arising from the main suit be transferred to the Court having competent jurisdiction, in order to avoid conflicting judgments.

In the interest of justice, since both the cases i.e. the main suit and the counter claim arising therefrom are required to be tried by one Court, in order to avoid conflicting judgments, the transfer petitions are allowed. The case bearing CS SCJ 184/2025 titled as *Jarnial Singh Chopra v. Dr. Seema Bhagat & Anr* and the Counter Claim No. 19/2025 titled as *Dr. Seema Bhagat & Anr v. Jarnail Singh Chopra* are withdrawn from the Court of Ld. Civil Judge-04, West, THC, Delhi and the same are transferred to the Court of Ld. District Judge-06, West, THC, Delhi, where the parties shall appear on **22.05.2026 at 3:00 PM.**

Copy of this order be sent to both the concerned Courts for necessary information and compliance.
