1. The present revision has been filed by revisionist/complainant company against impugned order dated 11/07/2025 of Ld. JMFC-01, South-East, through which the revisionist was directed to handover a gold coin, obtained on superdari, back to respondent (accused Manik Kadam).

2. It is observed that impugned order dated 11/07/2025 originates from a prior order dated 16/05/2025 of the Trial Court, through which it declined to take cognizance against accused Manik Kadam, while observing that there was a mere disclosure statement against him and a melted gold coin was recovered from his possession, whereas, there was no evidence to connect the melted coin with stolen property (gold articles).

3. It seems that, since the cognizance was not taken against accused Manik Kadam, Ld. Trial Court ordered restoration of seized gold coin back to him as a natural consequence of discharge from the case.

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4. The State and/or complainant have not filed any revision against impugned order dated 16/05/2025 of Ld. Trial Court, through which cognizance was declined as against accused Manik Kadam.

5. It is observed that the superdarinama of gold coin, furnished by complainant in PS Lajpat Nagar while obtaining gold coin from PS Malkhana on superdari, is not placed on record by SHO PS Lajpat Nagar.

Issue notice to SHO PS Lajpat Nagar to place the superdarinama of gold coin on record.

Put up for compliance by SHO PS Lajpat Nagar and arguments on revision on 20/01/2026.

Interim order to continue till next date.
