

ORDER BELOW EXH.04

The accused has filed the application for bail under the provision of Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. The accused has brought before the Court under the execution of non-bailable warrant on previous date. Neither the accused nor his advocate was present before the Court. No application was filed on behalf of the accused for exemption.

3. It is contended by the accused that on previous date, he was ill. Considering medical papers filed on record with the list of documents (Exh.05). In my view, the absence of the accused was not intentional. Therefore, the accused will have to be released on bail. Hence, the order :-

The accused is ordered to release on bail on executing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- (twenty five thousand) with a surety in the like amount.
