**ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF INTERIM BAIL
FILED ON BEHALF OF THE APPLICANT/ACCUSED PARUL**

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application for grant of interim bail for a period of 90 days filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Parul.
2. I have heard the counsel for the applicant/accused and the Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for State.
3. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused Parul submitted that in the present case, chargesheet has already been filed and case is at the stage of prosecution evidence and the present applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 21.04.2023. He has also submitted that the applicant/accused is having two minor children and her husband had died a month before her arrest in the present case. He has also submitted that minor son aged about 15 years of the applicant/accused is suffering from pneumonia, bronchitis septicemia, typhoid for last two months and at present his condition is very critical and he is under treatment, but he is not getting continuous treatment, due to which, his problem is increasing day by day, even blood is continuously coming out of his mouth and there is no one, except old aged grand parents, to take care of her ill son in the family of the applicant/accused.
4. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused Parul submitted that earlier also, the present applicant/accused was also granted

interim bail and it was also extended, however, after completing the period of interim bail, the applicant/accused had timely surrendered before the Jail authority and the applicant /accused did not misuse the said liberty of interim bail earlier granted to her and prayed for grant of interim bail for a period of 90 days to the applicant/accused so that she may get proper treatment to her minor son. In support of his submissions, Ld. Counsel has also filed photocopies of medical documents.

5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has vehemently opposed the present application and submitted that the applicant/accused has committed the offences punishable U/s. 302/201/120-B/34 IPC alongwith the co-accused persons and the offences committed by the accused are serious in nature, therefore, the present applicant/accused does not deserve the concession of interim bail.

6. As per the reply filed by the IO, the medical documents/treatment papers of patient Arman filed alongwith the present application have been verified.

7. The applicant/accused is alleged to have committed the offences punishable U/s. 302/201/120-B/34 IPC alongwith the co-accused persons and the offences allegedly committed by the accused are serious in nature. Charges have been framed and the case is at the stage of Prosecution Evidence.

8. As per the medical documents/treatment papers, son of the applicant/accused is getting treatment from Indra Nursing Home & Maternity Centre, Shanti Nagar, Loni, Ghaziabad, U.P. by Dr. Arun Aggarwal and this fact has also been verified by the IO.

9. Since, son of the applicant/accused is already getting treatment from the concerned doctor of Indra Nursing Home & Maternity Centre, Shanti Nagar, Loni, Ghaziabad, U.P., and the ailment does not seem to be too serious to grant interim bail to the present applicant/accused. Thus, there is no ground to release the applicant/accused on interim bail for the said purpose.

10. So, taking into consideration the nature of accusation, gravity of offences alleged to have been committed by this applicant/accused alongwith the co-accused persons and the fact that son of the applicant/accused is already getting treatment from the concerned doctor and that the case is at the initial stage of trial and evidence of the prosecution is going on, therefore, no ground is made out to grant interim bail to this applicant/accused at this stage.

11. In the above said terms, the application for grant of the interim bail filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Parul stands **dismissed**.
