RAVISH DUBEY AND ANR. Vs. STATE AND ANR.

Present : Mr. Vinod Fulara, Ld. counsel for applicants along-with the applicant no.1.

a) The present application has been moved under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking rectification/modification of the judgment and order dated 23.05.2026.

b) It is stated in the application that the name of the deceased mother of the petitioner has inadvertently been mentioned in the judgment as Late Smt. Aruna Dubey, whereas her correct name, as reflected in the Aadhaar Card placed on record, is Late Smt. Aruna Dube W/o Late Shri Ishwar Chandra Dubey. It is further submitted that although the petitioner had also sought grant of Letters of Administration in respect of fixed deposit Account No. 2572000100007060, no specific direction was issued to the concerned bank permitting the petitioner to operate the said account.

c) I have heard the submissions and perused the record.

d) The record reveals that the Aadhaar Card of the deceased filed along with the petition describes her as Late Smt. Aruna Dube W/o Late Shri Ishwar Chandra Dubey. Accordingly, the judgment and order dated 23.05.2026 stand rectified to the extent that wherever the name "Late Smt. Aruna Dubey" appears therein, it shall be read as "Late Smt. Aruna Dube."

e) As regards the second prayer, the operative portion of the judgment clearly grants the relief sought by the petitioner

in respect of all the properties mentioned in “Schedule B” of the petition, which includes the aforesaid deposit account. Therefore, no further or separate direction to the concerned bank permitting the petitioner to operate the said deposit account is required.

f) The application stands disposed of in the above terms.

g) The applicant has also moved an application seeking permission to deposit the requisite court fee and to furnish the administration bond in terms of the judgment dated 23.05.2026. The original court fee and the administration bond filed by the applicant are taken on record.

h) Let the Letters of Administration be issued in favour of the petitioner in terms of the judgment dated 23.05.2026, subject to completion of all necessary formalities. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

i) Ld. Counsel for the applicant also submitted that at the time of preparing inventory of the articles of the locker in question the applicant's key of the said locker was handed over to the Ld. Local Commissioner and same has been submitted by the Ld. LC before this court alongwith her report. Ld. Counsel prayed that the locker key be returned to the applicants.

j) In view of the submissions made the key the Locker be also released to the applicant.

k) Nothing further survives. File be consigned to the Record Room after due compliance.
