

Present:- Sh. Raman Chitra, Advocate for applicant Kashmiri.

Application for Superdari moved by applicant Kashmiri for release of vehicle bearing Regd. No. HR 16U 8165 being owner & which is taken in custody by the police in above F.I.R. Detailed reply from police was sought & received. Police report perused. Heard. Reading of reply and material on record prima facie shows that vehicle-in-question belongs to the applicant. Copy of RC is filed by applicant as per which name of Kashmiri son of Hookam Chand is real owner of the vehicle.

Vehicle had been taken into custody by the police, which has 'no objection' in releasing the same. The vehicle-in-question is in possession of the police and with the passage of time, it will outlive its utility if it remained parked in the premises of the Police Station due to non-use of the same. No useful purpose will be served if the vehicle-in-question is allowed to remain in the police station, as it will ultimately result into a junk.

Order

1. As a sequel, the vehicle-in-question i.e. vehicle bearing Regd. No. HR 16U 8165 is ordered to be released on superdari in favour of applicant Kashmiri, on his furnishing Superdarinama to the satisfaction of SHO concerned subject to the condition that the superdar shall produce the vehicle as and when required by the court, he shall not transfer or sell it without prior permission of the court. Security bond amount should be sufficiently near the current market value of the vehicle, determined preferably from its subsisting Insurance policy. Applicant shall remain bound by usual terms & conditions of Superdarinama.
2. Copy of this order be sent to S.H.O. Concerned for compliance of direction in red ink that before releasing the said vehicle, necessary photographs be taken, duly authenticated, dated and certified by the S.H.O. concerned and counter-signed by the Complainant, the Applicant, Accused; and, a detailed "Memo" be prepared along with requisite photographs taken from all sides. Valuation Report of vehicle in question be also taken. Thereafter, these Photographs / Valuation Report / Memo be filed with the challan.
3. Memo, inter alia, shall contain the following:
 1. Type of Vehicle, its make, model, and colour;

2. Engine Number;
 3. Chassis Number;
 4. Registration Number;
 5. Name of Owner and address as per Registration Certificate;
 6. Name & Address of Insurance Company.
4. Photographs should capture the Make, Model, Colour, Registration Number, Engine Number, and Chassis Number. Photographs shall be taken from all sides. If Digital photographs are taken then these should be accompanied by Section 65B, Evidence Act certificate. Original Digital Photographs be preserved till the decision of the case.
5. In case of default, S.H.O. concerned shall come present to explain the circumstances.
6. Copy of this order be issued to S.H.O. concerned for STRICT compliance. Papers be tagged with the main case file. Application stands disposed off with above directions.
