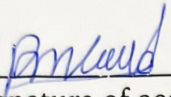

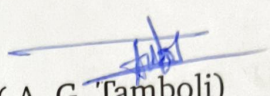

JUDGMENT

[Delivered on this 28th day of September 2024]

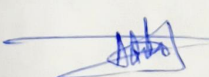
The accused has been prosecuted for offences punishable under section 66/192 and 130 177 of the Motor Vehicle Act.

02. The accused is present. He has filed a pursis pleading guilty to the offences charged with. On being inquired with him, this court is satisfied that the accused is voluntarily pleading guilty. He craves leniency with regard to infliction of punishment. He further submitted that, he is the only male earning member in his family. He is poor labour and his family is depend upon his earning from labourer work. Hence, he urged to impose minimum fine amount. Considering the nature of offence, submission of accused, financial status of the accused and the facts and circumstances of the case, I pass the following order-

ORDER

Accused is convicted U/s. 252 of Cr. P. C. for the offence punishable **U/s.66/192 MV Act** and **U/s 130 177 MV Act** in total **Rs. 1,100/- (in words eleven hundred only)** in default of payment of fine, accused shall undergo simple imprisonment of 6 days.
