Examination-in-chief:-

On 23.05.2024 at about 10.45 PM upon receiving at phone call I went to Sabroom hospital and found my brother-in-law Sri Purnendu Bikash Datta dead who brought by Fire Service. His body was kept in the morgue and next day after post-mortem handed over to me. Next morning I went to the accident spot and found live eletric wire hanged above the road and I suspect that due to electrocution from the wire my brother-in-law died. For the negligence of FEDCO Sabroom my brother-in-law electrocuted.

Cross- Examination:-

1. I did not mention to IO that, “Next morning I went to the accident spot and found live eletric wire hanged above the road

and I suspect that due to electrocution from the wire my brother-in-law died”.

2. I did not witness the accident by my own eyes.

3. It is not a fact that my entire examination-in-chief is false.

4. It is not a fact that due to storm the accident occurred and

Sri Purnendu Bikash Datta died.
