On 02.04.2026, an application of revisionist through Counsel was filed to serve the Respondent no.2 by affixation or by publication.

During the course of arguments, Ld. Counsel for the revisionist submits that though the aforesaid application has been filed for substitute service of Respondent no.2 only through publication ; whereas Respondent no.4 cannot be served by ordinary way as per reports received on issued processes earlier ; therefore, the application may also be considered for substitute service of Respondent no.4 through publication.

In the backdrop of earlier received reports on notices issued to Respondents no.2 and 4, it seems that Respondents no.2 and 4 cannot be served by ordinary way and accordingly, need arises to serve them by substitute service ; **so as prayed, let Respondents no.2 and 4 be served afresh by way of publication in newspapers (1) Dainik Jagran (Hindi edition) and (2) The Hindustan Times (English edition) (having circulation in the area of Delhi/New Delhi), for the date already fixed i.e. 30.04.2026.**

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Process be issued dasti as prayed and charges of publication are to be borne by the Revisionist.

Accordingly, the aforesaid application stands disposed.
