1. Heard.
2. This is a revision petition moved jointly by the petitioners, challenging the order dated 04.12.2025 and 13.12.2025 (hereinafter jointly referred to as the “impugned orders”) passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, South District, Saket Courts, Delhi in case titled as ***State v. Nitin Kochar @ Bhaskar & Anr.*** arising out of FIR No. 96/2016, police station Crime Branch, South. The petitioners are aggrieved that the Trial Court by passing of impugned orders has not only ordered to frame charge, but also proceeded framing charge against the accused persons (petitioner herein) under Section 385/120-B/417 IPC.

3. Mr. Santosh Kumar, learned APP for the State, accepts notice. The petitioners are directed to furnish the copy of the petition along with a list of documents and documents to the prosecution branch within seven days from today.
4. Issue notice to the respondents on filing of PF/Speed post/ authorized courier and also be given *dasti*, returnable for **18.04.2026**.
5. Let the reply to the petition be filed by the respondents within three weeks from the date of receipt of notice of petition with an advance copy of the same duly served upon the petitioner through counsel.
6. Liberty is granted to the parties to file the written arguments along with a list of judgements relied upon, preferably with neutral citation With an advance copy of the same duly served on the opposite party through counsel at least three days prior to the next date of hearing.
7. TCR be requisitioned on issuance of *robkar* at least two days prior to the next date of hearing.
