Arguments heard on the Transfer application / petition.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has filed three complaint cases under Section 138 of The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and all the three cases are pending before three different Courts, the details of which are as follows :

- a) CC NI Act No.7480/2024 titled as Ravinder Singh vs. Rajinder Singh Yadav pending in the Court of Ms. Archita Garg, Ld. JMFC (NI Act – 06), South, Saket Courts ;
- b) CC NI Act No.7485/2024 titled as Ravinder Singh vs. Rajinder Singh Yadav pending in the Court of Mr. Akshay Sharma, Ld. JMFC (NI Act – 08), South, Saket Courts ; and
- c) CC NI Act No.7497/2024 titled as Ravinder Singh vs. Rajinder Singh Yadav pending in the Court of Ms. Anshul Agnihotri, Ld. JMFC (NI Act) Digital Court - 03), South, Saket Courts.

It is further submitted that since in all the three cases parties are same and the dispute has also arisen out of same transaction, therefore, all the three cases be transferred to one Court in order to avoid conflicting orders and opinion.

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Ld. Counsel for the Respondent also conceded to the same and submits that he has no objection if all the three are transferred to one Court.

In view of the above, since in all the complaint cases parties are same and the dispute have arisen out of same transaction, it would be appropriate if all the complaint cases are tried by one Court in order to avoid conflicting orders and opinion. In these circumstances, **I hereby withdraw complaint cases bearing CC NI Act No.7485/2024 and CC NI Act No.7497/2024 from their respective Courts, and transferred the same to the Court of Ms. Archita Garg, Ld. JMFC (NI Act – 06), South, Saket Courts, where the connected case bearing CC NI Act No.7480/2024 is pending adjudication.**

Parties are directed to appear before the Ld. Transferee Court on 21.07.2026.

The Transfer application / petition is accordingly disposed of.

A copy of this order along with Trial Court records, if any, be sent back to concerned Trial Courts for information.
